NEW NAME FOR *LIOTHRIPS LORANTHI* MURALEEDHARAN & SEN (THYSANOPTERA: TUBULIFERA: PHLAEOTHRIPIDAE)

Liothrips loranthi Muraleedharan & Sen, 1981 Rec. zool. Surv. India, 79: 215-217.

The name Liothrips loranthi Muraleedharan & Sen is preocupied by Liothrips loranthi Priesner (1968, Treubia, 27 (2-3): 211-212). It is a strange coincidence that both the species are named after the host plant Loranthus. Liothrips loranthi Muraleedharan & Sen is a distinct species differing from the other species (Liothrips loranthi Priesner) by

antennal, wing & setae coloration, anteromarginal setae longer than anteroangulars and number of double fringes of forewings. Therefore a new name Liothrips bournieri nom. nov. is proposed for Liothrips loranthi Muraleedharan & Sen.

The new name is proposed after Prof. A. Bournier for his valuable contribution on Thysanoptera and also for kindly bringing the homonymy to my notice.
